

MAHB YEAR-END AWARD CRITERIA

- 1. Horse must be owned or bred by a current MAHB member.** Only current members can win an award. They must be a member when the horse's scores are earned. They may submit scores for horses they sold and are being shown by the new owner but the horse must have been bred by them. They may submit scores for horses that they purchased and currently own, and did not breed, but the scores must be earned while they owned the horse.
- 2. In-Hand:** Scores may be submitted from any USDF recognized IBC class or points from any USEF hunter breeding class.
- 3. Under Saddle:** Dressage scores may be submitted from any recognized USDF competition.
- 4.** The average of the highest two scores or points submitted will be used. Scores or points must be earned under 2 different judges for Breed awards. Scores must be earned at two different shows and 2 different judges for Dressage awards.
- 5.** An award for the In-Hand classes will be given in three categories to the horse with the highest average. In the case of a tie in a category we will give two awards.
 1. DSHB -Young Horse
 2. DSHB - Mature Horse
 3. Hunter Breeding - Any Age
- 6.** An award for Dressage classes will be given for the following categories. In the case of a tie in a category we will give two awards.
 1. Training Level, any test, Open and AA
 2. First Level, any test, Open and AA
 3. Second Level, any test, Open and AA
